/ti'tano/ Little Constellation at the Titano Theatre Sunday,8 December 2013 Opening from 6 PM to 10 PM

The contemporary art exhibition /ti'tano/ little constellation, a specific project of Little Constellation Network, dedicated to the promotion of young artists from geo-cultural micro-areas and small States of Europe, will open on **Sunday 8 December**, from 6PM to 10PM, in the historical location of the Titano Theatre in the Republic of San Marino.

The evening will be inaugurated by On.Li **Giuseppe Maria Morganti**, Minister for Education and Culture and **Matteo Fiorini**, Minister for the Territory and Youth Policy of the Republic of San Marino, together with **Emiliano Paoletti**, Secretary General BJCEM - Biennale des Jeunes Créateurs de l'Europe et de la Méditerranée.

Through an intensive programme of performances, presentations, concerts, installations, visual set live and dj-set, this event intends to provide a detailed overview of the contemporary art scene represented by young artists performing in similar geo-cultural areas, such as: Andorra, Cyprus, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Monaco, San Marino, Canton Ticino, Aland Islands, Faroe Islands, Italy and Lebanon.

Such event represents the last stage of a research process started in 2011 and carried out through meetings, laboratories, conferences and exhibitions taking place at Villa Croce, the Contemporary Art Museum of Genoa, the National Gallery of Iceland and the World Event Young Artists in Nottingham. It concluded as a project of the Republic of San Marino at the **Mediterranea 16 Biennial of Young Artists** - **Errors allowed**, **Ancona 2013**.

/ti'tano/ is a unique research activity, which uses the investigation techniques of cultural anthropology, based on experience and direct knowledge of places, to outline, for the first time ever, a number of new proposals. The project aims to be an instrument to present a particular point of view, both central and peripheral, which allows to listen to unexpected voices in the international critical and artistic debate.

Finally, this exhibition will be an opportunity to present the volume on the entire project published by **Mousse Publishing**, Milan. Such volume is an important book providing documentary evidence and disclosing the outcome of the in-depth research process undertaken.

/ti'tano/ has been an exciting journey, which has been made possible thanks to Little Constellation's founders, Rita Canarezza and Pier Paolo Coro, the curator Alessandro Castiglioni and the support provided by the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Ministry of Territory and Youth Policies of the Republic of San Marino, as well as to the Office for Social and Cultural Activities - member and founder of the International Association BJCEM - Biennial of Young Artists from Europe and the Mediterranean, which has been successfully attended by San Marino artists since
